

## Announcement of the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University Subject: Guidelines for English Proficiency Test-takers during the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) (Omicron Variant) Outbreak

(No. 3) 2022


This is an announcement regarding the re-opening of Mahidol University at Salaya campus in compliance with the Measures to Prevent and Control the Outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) notice on the 1<sup>st</sup> May 2022. The Faculty of Graduate Studies (FGS) at Mahidol University instructs English proficiency test-takers to take the following steps:

- 1. Test-takers are required to complete the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) screening form 2 days prior the exam date using <a href="https://forms.gle/JvjYJ9WriBfvaNWi6">https://forms.gle/JvjYJ9WriBfvaNWi6</a>.
- 2. Test takers are required to submit negative results from either PT-PCR or Rapid Antigen Test Kits (ATK) COVID-19 test to the Faculty of Graduate Studies 2 days prior the examination date. Results must not exceed 48 hours before the examination date.
- 3. Rapid Antigen Test Kits (ATK) and PT-PCR test results submission is as follows:
  - 3.1 For the self-administered tests, test-takers are required to write first and last name/ date of screening/ time of screening on the ATK test kit, take a photo of the test kit and send it to the Language Center Section Line at @693lascg.
  - 3.2 If one is tested by an organization certified by the Department of Medical Sciences or the Ministry of Public of Public Health, one to scan their results and send it to the Language Center Section Line at @693lascg.
- 4. Those who have contracted COVID-19 or show any symptoms associated with COVID-19 will not be allowed to take the test. Test-takers can postpone the test once. Note that the application fee is non-refundable. Take testers who have tested positive for COVID-19 ought to notify the Faculty of Graduate Studies immediately. Those who notify after the examination date will not be able to reschedule their examination and will be ineligible for a refund.

5. In the event that a test-taker does not provide COVID-19 negative results, he or she is not allowed to enter the examination room.

The announcement shall be acknowledged and taken in effect since  $1^{\rm st}$  June 2022 onwards
