### **The Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University**

#### **Subject: Preventive Measures Concerning the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) Infection and Guidelines for English Proficiency Examination**

Since the outbreak situation of Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) infection continues, the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University has realized the danger and the risks caused by this infectious disease. In order to ensure safety of examinees, the Faculty of Graduate Studies hereby issues the preventive measures against the spreading of COVID-19 and the guidelines for English proficiency test as follows:

#### **1. Preparation measures for the venue before and after the test**

- 1.1. Floor cleaning, both inside and outside the examination room, is conducted before and after the test.
- 1.2. Hourly cleaning of equipment with touching surfaces, such as door handles, stair handrails, and bathrooms, is conducted. (The use of elevators is prohibited.)
- 1.3. Cleaning with disinfectants is conducted on desks, chairs, computer sets, examination equipment and stationery before and after the test.
- 1.4. Proctors are required to wear facial masks and/or face shields at all times.
- 1.5. The queue for registration is marked to indicate 1-meter distancing.

#### **2. Measures for test-takers and guidelines for the test**

- 2.1. Thermal screenings of all test-takers are required in the lobby area on the first floor of the Faculty of Graduate Studies Building. Any test-taker with body temperature exceeding 37.5 Degrees Celsius is not allowed to enter the test room, and he or she shall leave his or her first name, last name, telephone number, and email address with the designated test administrator for re-scheduling the test at a later time.
- 2.2. Test-takers are required to wear facial masks and/or face shield at all times. Any test-taker who refuses to wear a facial mask is not allowed to enter the test room.
- 2.3. Test-takers are required to clean their hands with hand sanitizers provided at the registration desk and at the test room entrance.

- 2.4. Test-takers are required to use the “Thai Chana” mobile application for checking in and out at 2 areas:
- 2.4.1. On the first floor of the Faculty of Graduate Studies Building
  - 2.4.2. At the waiting area of the test room.
- 2.5. To minimize the risks of contracting the COVID-19 infection, the test-taker, who finishes his or her test before the time limit, is allowed to leave the test room immediately.

The announcement shall be acknowledged and taken in effect in strict compliance.
