



**Operative Guidelines toward the Minimum Requirements of Thai Language Proficiency for
Foreign Students in Thai-delivered Graduate Programs
of Mahidol University B.E. 2564**

According to the resolutions of the 3/2564 and 5/2564 meetings of Resolution Graduate Curricula Committee on Monday 22nd February B.E. 2564 and Monday 22nd March B.E. 2564, respectively, the Faculty of Graduate Studies hereby announces the operative guidelines toward the minimum requirements of Thai language proficiency for foreign students in Thai-delivered graduate programs as follows:

1. The foreign applicants must attend the Thai Language Aptitude Test for Foreigners conducted by the Office of the Basic Education Commission (OBEC), Ministry of Education, at the “**Lower Secondary**” level; or
2. The applicants must attend the Chulalongkorn University Proficiency Test of Thai as a Foreign Language (CU-TFL) conducted by Sirindhorn Thai Language Institute, Chulalongkorn University, and must garner a grade at a “**Advanced**” level; or
3. The applicants must obtain a bachelor’s or graduate degree of a Thai-delivered program at a university in Thailand; or
4. The applicants must obtain a bachelor’s or graduate degree in a Thai language from a university in Thailand or foreign university.
