Subject: English Competence Standards of Faculty of Graduate Studies,

#### **Mahidol University**

B.E. 2558

This announcement clarifies the English competence standards for graduate students, Mahidol University, in accordance with the Ministry of Education directive entitled "Methods of Graduate Program Standards Management B.E. 2548" and Mahidol University's Academic Regulations of Graduate Studies B.E. 2556, which states that all graduate programs have to place an importance on English language and ensure the standards and the quality of graduate studies at Mahidol University in accordance with the regulations of the Office of the Higher Education Commission.

Following the resolution of the 7<sup>th</sup> of B.E. 2558 meeting of the Graduate Studies Committee on 15<sup>th</sup> July 2015, the Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University announced the required English competence standards for the graduate students of Mahidol University as follows:

- This announcement applies to all graduate students who choose English as their optional foreign language under the Mahidol University's Academic Regulations of the Graduate Studies B.E. 2556
- 2. The English Competence Standard of Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University B.E.2553, item no.3: the English Competence Standards and English Competence Assessment Criteria of Doctoral Degree Students, announced on 28<sup>th</sup> January B.E.2553 is annulled.
- 3. English Competence Standards and English Competence Assessment Criteria of Doctoral Degree Students (Thai and International Program)

All doctoral degree students must have:

- 3.1 an IELTS score with a minimum of 5.0 or
- 3.2 a TOEFL IBT score with a minimum of 61 or
- 3.3 a TOEFL ITP score with a minimum of 500 or
- 3.4 In the case where a doctoral degree student has
  - an IELTS score lower than 5.0 or
  - a TOEFL IBT score lower than 61 or
  - a TOEFL ITP score lower than 500, the student must take the following course(es):

# 3.4.4 Anyone who has

- a TOEFL ITP score lower than 400 or
- a TOEFL IBT score lower than 32 or
- an IELTS score <u>lower than 3.0</u> shall not be accepted as a doctoral degree student in Mahidol University.
- 4. Any case that is NOT included or addressed by the criteria above shall be under the consideration of the Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University.
