



Announcement of Mahidol University

On Teaching Guideline and Routine Work During the State of Emergency in Bangkok

Reference is made to the government's announcement on the state of emergency in Bangkok area dated the 15th October 2020, Mahidol University has carefully evaluated the situation and convinced that the gatherings may be happening in Phyathai campus and other campuses close to the university's premises. Taking into account the safety of students, academic and supporting staff, Mahidol University would like to announce the followings:

1. Heads of faculties/institutes and colleges in Phyathai, Bangkok Noi and Salaya campuses are to consider, as seen appropriate, the utilization of online teaching and learning methods during this period. Provided that there are research/laboratory-related activities which require the use of the university's premises or facilities, all heads of faculties/institutes and colleges are requested to consider, with utmost importance, the safety and convenience of students and academic staff in commuting back and forth to the premises.
2. Heads of faculties/institutes and colleges in Phyathai, Bangkok Noi and Salaya campuses are to authorize, as seen appropriate, the re-adjustment of the onsite working hours of supporting staff during this period by allowing the staff to leave early without considering as personal leaves. Also, work from home could be considered, as seen appropriate, taking into account the efficiency and effectiveness of the institutional missions.
3. Vice Presidents/Heads of faculties/institutes and colleges in all campuses are to consider the necessity of organizing non-academic activities, taking into account the safety and convenience of students, academic and supporting staff in commuting back and forth to the campuses.

This announcement enters into effect from the 19th October 2020 onwards until further change and notice.
