1. All the international students are highly suggested to follow the announcement of the Mahidol University. At present, classes from the Salaya campuses has been postponed from March 16 to March 20, 2020. The College of Sport Science will be closed from 14 to 22 March, 2020.
2. According to the university announcement, the students who are returning from a COVID-19 affected areas must conduct a self-quarantine at their accommodation for a period of 14 days.
3. Please avoid unnecessary travel during the outbreak of COVID-19. If you have no serious reasons, you are suggested not to travel abroad or not to go back to home country for the time being.
4. In case you are going back to your home country, please continue to stay there till further announcement is made. The programs will contact for online mode of study or make-up class will be scheduled later.
5. If you suspect yourself of having contracted with the COVID-19 or develop fever or the respiratory symptoms, please notify us (by either phone, email, or LINE) and we will help you for contacting MU Health or hospitals for further processes.
6. Please avoid the crowd, protect yourself while out in public, wash your hands frequently, and practice social distancing that is to maintain a distance of about 2 metres from others.
