“2024 Mahidol Postgraduate Scholarships” for international students

Under “The 60th Year Supreme Reign of His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej
Scholarship” Academic Year 2024

1. Rationales

Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University, in collaboration with the graduate programs of Mahidol University, acknowledges the importance of opportunities for deserving students to pursue their education at graduate levels. The “*2024 Mahidol Postgraduate Scholarships*” has been initiated to offer international students for scholarships which cover tuition fees and other expenses while studying in the graduate programs of Mahidol University. Those students who have satisfactory academic records and are in need of financial support shall have a chance to study in Mahidol University. This scholarship has been initiated in accordance to the Mahidol University’s Social Development Goal 4 (SDGs 4: Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all. In additions this scholarship also aims to increase the number of scholars and researchers in various disciplines as well as will create the relations and ties between Mahidol University and grantees’ countries of origin.

2. Objectives

2.1. To promote and support international students with excellent academic records in pursuing their study for master’s and doctoral degrees at Mahidol University

2.2. To support the University policy on increasing the number of highly qualified master’s and doctoral international students in various fields of study

3. Participating programs

information about the participating programs and any other announcement related with the scholarship.

4. Scholarship Types and contribution

There will be 2 categories of scholarships to be provided to the students, type 1 (full scholarship) and type 2 (partial scholarship). In general, type 1 is the scholarship that provides all the program study fee as well as living allowance to the student. The scholarship type 2 (partial scholarship) the student has to pay education fee 20% only. There will be no living allowance provided to the student in the scholarship type 2.

4.1 Scholarship Duration

- up to 3 academic years for a student pursuing Doctoral degree.
- up to 2 academic years for a student pursuing Master's degree.

5. Requirement to apply for scholarship

5.1 Applicants for **master's program** must obtained a **Bachelor's degree** with following details;

Other requirements

5.1.1 Must not receive a scholarship or sponsored from any other scholarship provider/Government/Statutory Bodies or any other organization

5.1.2 Must not exceed 40 years of age at the time of application

5.1.3 Must submit an essay stating why the applicant is entitled to receive the scholarship (not more than 1,000 words)

5.1.4 Exemption from above criteria may be considered on case by case by the scholarship committee, Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University.

5.2 Doctoral program

5.2.1 For applicants with **Master's degree** with following details;

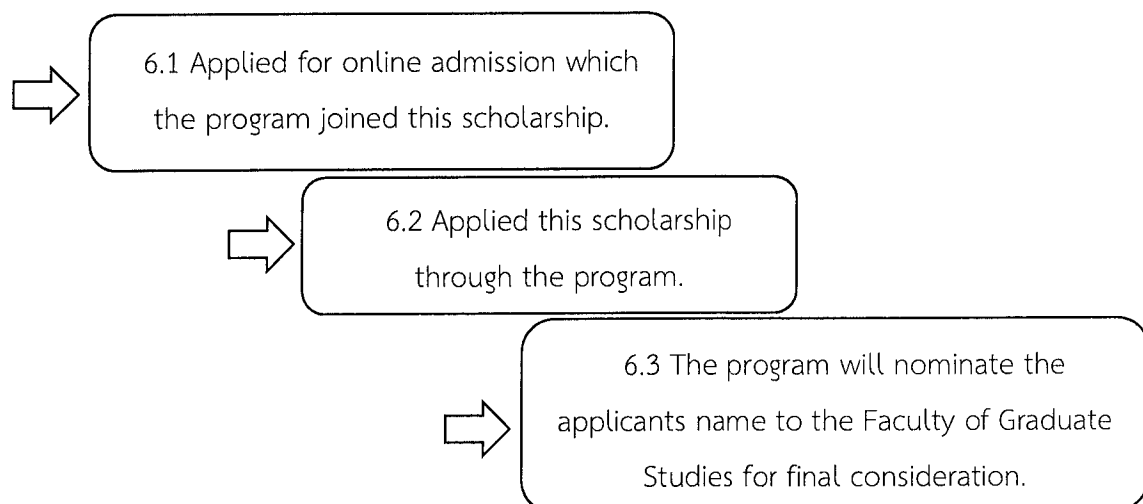

5.2.2 For applicants with Bachelor's degree with following details;

Other requirements

1. Must not receive a scholarship or sponsored from any other scholarship provider/Government/Statutory Bodies or any other organization
2. Must not exceed 45 years of age at the time of application
3. Must submit an essay stating why the applicant is entitled to receive the scholarship (not more than 1,000 words)
4. Exemption from above criteria may be considered on case by case by the Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University

6. Application Selection and Evaluation Process

The selection committee of Faculty of Graduate Studies will review and determine successful candidates based on the ranking for the best merit of the students and according to the number of grants provided. The decisions from the committee are irrevocable, and no further appeal shall be made.

7. Leave or absent from study

The scholarship recipient may take a voluntarily suspend study for maximum 1 semester. However, the scholarship recipient must self-responsible for the payment of voluntarily suspend study fee.

8. Scholarship condition

8.1 The Doctoral Degree who receives a type 1 scholarship must publish a Review Article with the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University in acknowledgement of the Review Article (Q1 or Q2) within 2 academic years from the date of signing contract.

8.2 For the payment of living allowance, it will be started offering once the scholarship recipient joins the on-campus classes and will be offered up to 24 months for Master's degree and up to 36 months for Doctoral degree or till the scholarship recipient passes the final thesis defense examination whichever comes first.

8.3 The living allowances will be temporarily suspended if the scholarship recipient:

a: stays outside Thailand for more than 2 months (except for the reason that travelling to other country as an exchange student).

b: take a voluntarily suspend study (as item 7).

9. Termination of scholarship

The scholarship will be provided according to the number of years stipulated in the Scholarship Agreement or until the scholarship recipient drops out of the scholarship. However, Faculty of Graduate Studies reserves the right to terminate the scholarship anytime if:

9.1 The scholarship recipient's academic performance not achieving minimum CGPA of 3.5 for both Master's and Doctoral studies (for coursework) per academic year and not obtaining satisfactory result from thesis progress report, and the Grade Report of each semester is lower than B, or, either of I, U or F.

9.2 The scholarship recipient involves in any misconduct or infringement of rules and regulations of Mahidol University,

9.3 Student status of the scholarship recipient has been terminated or the student resigns from the program or absence from the study for more than one semester, or absence without appropriate reason.

9.4 The scholarship recipient has not officially published Review Article within 2 academic years. (for Doctoral degree who receive type 1 scholarship)

9.5 The scholarship recipient has rejected the scholarship before scholarship ended.

9.6 The scholarship recipient takes a voluntarily suspend study more than 1 semester.

9.7 The scholarship will be ended according to the duration of the scholarship.

* The scholarship recipients who meet any of the condition mentioned in item no 9.1, 9.2, 9.3, 9.4, 9.5 or 9.6 are required to reimburse the Faculty of Graduate Studies with the total scholarship amount.

10. In case of other procedures or conditions not indicated in this announcement, the scholarship committee shall review the issue on case-by-case basis.
