Subject: Scholarship project for Graduate-student Assistants of Students with Disability

Academic Year 2022

The Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University, offers scholarship to assistants of students with disability in Master's and Doctoral degrees.

1. Objectives

The objectives of this project are to encourage graduate students who are assistants of students with disability of the Faculty of Graduate Studies, to acquire public mind, and contribute services to the society.

2. Qualifications

2.1 Be a graduate student of Mahidol University under any Master's or Doctoral programs (except those offered by the International College and the College of Management), holding a student status in the second semester of the first academic year or higher at the semester the scholarship is granted.

2.2 Hold consecutive enrollment records with no reports of study leave without permissions, as stipulated in the Academic Regulations of Mahidol University.

2.3 Have the cumulative GPA of two consecutive semesters as follows:

- Master's degree: GPA of at least 3.25

- Doctoral degree: GPA of at least 3.50

In cases where grades of certain courses are still in progress, the responsible instructor of the course or the program director will be appointed to provide opinions toward candidates' academic performances.

2.4 Never hold any misconduct records according to the University Regulations

2.5 Have advisors of the students with disability report reasons and necessities toward nominating assistants for the students, and indicate the responsibilities of such assistants, which shall be approved by the chair of the program administrative committee.

2.6 Do not hold a provisional student status.

3. Number of grants

- Master’s degree: 10 awards THB 4,000 per month per semester
(no more than 4 months for a semester)
- Doctoral degree: 5 awards THB 5,000 per month per semester
(no more than 4 months for a semester)

4. Candidacy and successful candidate announcement

5. Scholarship conditions

5.1 Do not hold misconducts or violate the student conduct code as of the University Regulations.

5.2 Hold consecutive enrollment records with no reports of study leave without permissions, as stipulated in the Academic Regulations of Mahidol University.

5.3 Receive a grade no less than “B” in cases where there are some courses to be enrolled as stipulated in the curriculum or as suggested by advisors.

5.4 Receive a grade of “P” or “S” in the thesis/dissertation course.

5.5 Be available after study hours to academically assist students with disability.

5.6 Spend 5 to 10 hours per week in doing as stated in clause 5.5.

5.7 Submit assistance reports every two months.

6. Scholarship suspension

The Faculty of Graduate Studies will cease the scholarship when one of the following cases applies:

6.1 Such a grantee has no longer a student status or resign from the university.

6.2 Such a grantee has misconducted reports or has misbehaved toward regulations and desirable disciplines of the university and the program/ faculty/ institute/ college in which he/she studies.

6.3 Such a grantee ceases his/her study or holds a study leave without valid reasons.

6.4 In terms of study reports, such a grantee cannot satisfy the study condition as stipulated in the scholarship conditions section.

6.5 Such a grantee does not respect the scholarship conditions, as suggested and assigned by his/her study program.

6.6 Such a grantee does not contact the Faculty of Graduate Studies within one month to receive the monthly scholarship, counting from the last contact.

6.7 The Faculty of Graduate Studies does not receive any assistance report.

7. Should any grantee fail to satisfy the scholarship conditions as stipulated in this announcement, the Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies would consider the issue on a case-by-case basis.
