“2026 Mahidol Postgraduate Scholarships” for International Students

Academic Year 2026

### 1. Rationale

The Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University, in collaboration with the University’s graduate programs, recognizes the importance of supporting capable and deserving international students in pursuing graduate-level education. The 2026 Mahidol Postgraduate Scholarships have been established to provide international students with financial support, including tuition fees and additional expenses, while studying in graduate programs at Mahidol University.

This initiative aligns with Mahidol University’s Social Development Goal 4 (SDG 4): Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all. The scholarship also aims to increase the number of scholars and researchers in various disciplines and to strengthen academic ties between Mahidol University and recipients’ home countries.

### 2. Objectives

2.1 To promote and support international students with strong academic records in pursuing master’s and doctoral degrees at Mahidol University.

2.2 To support the University’s policy of increasing the number of highly qualified international graduate students across various fields of study.

### 3. Eligibility Criteria for Scholarship Applicants

3.1 Applicants must be international students eligible for enrollment in a master’s or doctoral degree program in the academic year 2026 in any faculty or program, except for the following:

- Faculty of Medicine Siriraj Hospital
- Faculty of Medicine Ramathibodi Hospital
- Faculty of Environment and Resource Studies
- Faculty of Tropical Medicine
- Faculty of Information and Communication Technology
- International College
- College of Music
- College of Management
- Any joint program where the Faculty of Medicine Siriraj Hospital or the Faculty of Medicine Ramathibodi Hospital is listed as the primary faculty

3.2 Applicants to **Master's programs must obtained a Bachelor's degree**. Academic Requirement:

CGPA	English Proficiency Requirement	Publication
Minimum CGPA: 3.25 (81.25%)	1. IELTS = 5 (writing=5, speaking=5) or 2. TOEFL iBT = 64 (writing =17, speaking =15) or 3. MU ELT = 84 (writing =10, speaking =10) or 4. MU GRAD Plus = 70 (writing =10, speaking =10) <b>* English score must not exceed 2 years</b>	Publication in a recognized indexed journal is <b>an added advantage but not mandatory</b> .

3.3 Applicants to the **Doctoral programs (Master's Degree Holders)**. Academic Requirement:

CGPA	English Proficiency Requirement	Publication
Minimum CGPA: 3.50 (87.50%)	1. IELTS = 6 (writing=6, speaking=6) or 2. TOEFL iBT = 79 (writing =23, speaking =19) or 3. MU GRAD Plus = 90 (writing =12, speaking =12) <b>* English score must not exceed 2 years</b>	At least one research article in a journal indexed in a database accepted by Mahidol University.

3.4 Applicants to the **Doctoral programs (Bachelor's Degree Holders)**. Academic Requirement:

CGPA	English Proficiency Requirement	Publication
Minimum CGPA: 3.25 (81.25%)	<b>English Proficiency Requirement:</b> As in Section 3.3	Publication in an indexed journal is <b>an added advantage but not mandatory</b> .

#### 4. Scholarship Types and contribution

##### 4.1 Program Quota Type

The Faculty of Graduate Studies covers:

- Master's: up to 20,000 THB/semester
- Doctoral: up to 25,000 THB/semester

**Additional fees covered by the program:**

- Any excess tuition fees beyond the subsidized amount will be deducted from the program's allocated funds.
- Research and / or equipment fees (if any)
- Worksite study fees (if any)

##### 4.2 The Central Quota Type

The Faculty of Graduate Studies covers:

- Fixed-rate tuition fees (same rates as above)
- Living allowance: 10,000 THB/month

**Additional fees covered by the program:**

- Any excess tuition fees beyond the subsidized amount will be deducted from the program's allocated funds.
- Research and/or equipment fees (if any)
- Worksite study fees (if any)

##### 4.3 Student is responsible for:

- Application fee
- New student enrollment fee
- Health Insurance fee
- Summer semester fee (if applicable)

#### 4.4 Scholarship Duration

- Doctoral degree: up to 3 academic years (6 semesters)
- Master's degree: up to 2 academic years (4 semesters)

#### 4.5 Early Completion

If the recipient passed the thesis defense before the scholarship period ends, scholarship support will end at that time.

### 5. Disbursement Method

5.1 Tuition fee support will be applied directly each semester. Any excess beyond the covered amount will be deducted from the program's allocated funds.

5.2 Research, equipment, and worksite study fees will be deducted from the program's allocated funds.

5.3 Summer semester fees must be paid by the student.

5.4 Living allowance (Central Quota) is provided until the student passes the thesis defense or the scholarship period ends.

### 6. Application Selection and Evaluation Process

#### 6.1 Program Quota Type

Programs submit eligible candidates to the Faculty of Graduate Studies.

## 7. Application for Scholarship and Submission of Eligible Scholarship Recipients

7.1 Applicant must contact their program directly to apply.

7.2 Programs must submit eligible candidates according to the schedule. Late submissions will not be considered.

7.3 Any remaining Program Quota scholarships may be reallocated to the Central Quota at the discretion of the Faculty of Graduate Studies. Program Quota scholarships cannot be carried forward for use in the second semester of Academic Year 2026. Programs must submit the list of Program Quota scholarship recipients within the deadlines specified in Section 6.1; otherwise, the unsubmitted quota will be considered forfeited and may be reassigned through the Central Quota.

## 8. Required Documents

Applicants must submit the official scholarship application form to your program coordinator and:

- Passport copy
- Academic transcript
- Degree certificate
- English proficiency test results, as specified by the Faculty of Graduate Studies
- Indexed publications (if applicable), with highlighted name and Quartile/Impact Factor information

## 9. Scholarship Conditions

9.1 Recipients must sign a scholarship agreement before receiving any benefits.

9.2 Recipients must participate in:

- Scholarship award ceremony
- At least two additional Graduate School activities during the scholarship period

9.3 Central Quota Doctoral recipients must publish a **Q1 or Q2 Review Article** within 2 academic years.

## 10. Termination of Scholarship

10.1 Completion of scholarship period

10.2 Voluntary withdrawal

10.3 Leave of absence without valid reasons

10.4 Misconduct or violation of university rules

10.5 Recommendation from the Program Committee to suspension of the scholarship

10.6 Academic performance below required CGPA (Master's < 3.25, Doctoral < 3.50)

10.7 Receiving a grade of C, D, F, or U

10.8 Failure to publish the required Review Article (Central Quota Doctoral)

**\* If any of the above conditions are violated, the student must repay the full scholarship amount.**

## 11. Additional Provisions

Matters not covered in this announcement shall be decided at the discretion of the Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies.
