2019 Mahidol Postgraduate Scholarships

for Graduate International Students (Second Semester)

1. Background

To provide educational opportunity and encourage diversity, the Faculty of Graduate Studies, in collaboration with faculties, institutes, and colleges in Mahidol University, is to launch the “2019 Mahidol Postgraduate Scholarships” for international students pursuing master’s and doctoral degrees at the university. The scholarship, which covers the cost of attendance and other expenses, will be offered to international students who have excellent academic records and are in need of financial support. This serves not only to increase the number of scholars and researchers in various disciplines, but also to build strong connection between Mahidol University and grantees’ countries of residence.

2. Objectives

2.1 To encourage high caliber international students who have excellent academic records and wish to pursue their master’s or doctoral degrees at Mahidol University.

2.2 To build strong connection and network between Mahidol University and grantees’ countries of residence.

3. Eligibility Requirements

3.1 Applicants must be international students aiming to pursue their master’s or doctoral degrees at Mahidol University in the academic year 2019. Names of degrees and programs are listed at the end of this announcement.

3.2 Applicants must request their previous university to send an authentic and complete English version with official translation, certified with official seal or stamp of the university authorized office of the following academic records:-

1) Certificate of Graduation and

2) Academic Transcript including all evaluation results and graduation date

and have them directly reach Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University by November 2, 2019.

3.3 Applicants must request the official test centers to submit their score report for English Proficiency Standardized Testing of TOEFL- iBT or IELTS and have it directly reach the Language Center Section, Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University by November 2, 2019.

3.4 Grants for Master's Students

An applicant must:

3.4.1 hold a bachelor's degree with a cumulative GPA. of no less than 3.25.

3.4.2 submit either one of the following English proficiency test scores:

- IELTS academic module with a score of 5 or higher;
- TOEFL iBT with a score of 54 or higher;
- TOEFL ITP (Mahidol University) with a score of 480 or higher;
- MU GRAD TEST with a score of 60 or higher.

3.5 Grants for Doctoral Students

An applicant must:

3.5.1 hold a master's degree with a cumulative GPA. of no less than 3.50 (a special consideration will be given to applicants who have publications in internationally-recognized academic journals. Evidences of publications must be submitted with the application.)

3.5.2 submit either one of the following English proficiency test scores:

- IELTS academic module with a score of 5 or higher;
- TOEFL iBT with a score of 61 or higher;
- TOEFL ITP (Mahidol University) with a score of 500 or higher.

4. Benefits and Terms

4.1 Type II Partial scholarships: This scholarship will cover partial study fee but not living allowance. The total of 100 partial scholarships will be available. Details of each partial scholarship categories are as follows:

4.1.1 Partial Scholarship Type I: This scholarship will cover all the fee according^s to the requirement of the program. The living allowance will not be included.

4.1.2 Partial Scholarship Type II: This scholarship will cover 50% of the study fee according to the requirement of the program. The living allowance will not be included.

4.1.3 Partial Scholarship Type III: The study fee of this type of scholarship will be granted at the same rate as Thai student. The living allowance will not be included.

Some fee payments must originate from the scholarship recipient in advance. The recipient must therefore prepare to pay the fees in advance and make a claim for reimbursement of eligible expenses.

5. Scholarship Terms

- Maximum 24 months for Master degree
- Maximum 36 months for Doctoral degree

6. Application Procedure

6.1 Candidates are to submit the degree program application form together with the scholarship application forms through the programs in which they would like to apply.

6.2 The Degree Program Committee will select and submit the names of qualified candidates to the Faculty of Graduate studies for the final selection and approval process.

7. Required Documents

Interested candidates are to submit the application form, the scholarship application form along with the following documents to the degree program:

8. Selection Process

The Selection Committee will be appointed by the Faculty of Graduate Studies to determine successful candidates. The decisions from the Committee are irrevocable, and no further appeal shall be made.

9. Scholarship Acceptance

The Faculty of Graduate Studies shall provide Scholarship Agreement for grantees to sign. The funding will start in the first semester of academic year 2019. However, the successful awardees shall prepare their own living allowance for the first two months of their arrival in case of a delay process of the payment at the beginning.

10. Scholarship Termination

10.1 At the end of the agreed scholarship period.

10.2 The scholarship recipient renounces the scholarship.

10.3 The scholarship recipient is dismissed, or resigns as a student, or takes a leave of absence without good reasons and permission.

10.4 The recipient is involved in any misconduct or disciplinary actions according to the regulations of Mahidol University and/or the program/ faculty/ college to which the scholarship recipient belongs.

10.5 The Chair of the Program to which the scholarship recipient belongs, requests the suspension of the scholarship.

- 10.6 The scholarship recipient shows poor academic performance as follows:
- Doctoral degree scholarship recipients have a GPA in an academic year lower than 3.50
 - Master's degree scholarship recipients have a GPA in an academic year lower than 3.25
- 10.7 The registered course evaluation report shows a result of C or U.
- 10.8 The scholarship recipient take suspend study more than one semester.

11. In case of other procedures or conditions not indicated in this announcement, the Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies shall review the issue on case-by-case basis.
