The Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University Scholarship to Promote Master and Doctoral Students' Competency For International Academic Presentations, Fiscal Year 2023

The Faculty of Graduate Studies aims to provide scholarships for our master and doctoral students in presenting their own academic research in an international presentation. The application procedure and selection criteria for Fiscal Year 2023, are as follows:

1. Qualifications

1.1 The applicant must be a student in a Master's or Doctoral program of the institute under the financial supervision of the Faculty of Graduate Studies (excluding the programs offered by Faculty of Medical Technology, Faculty of Tropical Medicine, Faculty of Environment and Resource Studies, Faculty of Information and Communication Technology, Mahidol University International College, College of Music, and College of Management). In addition, the candidate must be invited to attend an international conference.

1.2 The applicant must be a master's (plan A) or doctoral student who passed the thesis proposal examination, and receives the thesis topic and advisory committee approval. The applicant must not be a student who receives a scholarship from a sponsoring source to present academic work abroad.

1.3 The applicant must not have previously received this scholarship from the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University.

1.4 An applicant must be listed as a first author or co-author of the abstracts presented in the conference. In addition, the name of the applicant's faculty/college/institute and Mahidol University must be mentioned as the affiliation of the presenter as well as the logo of Mahidol University must be shown in either a poster or oral presentation.

1.5 In the case of receiving partial support for the same presentation from any other sources, please also specify its details for our consideration purpose.

1.6 In case it is later found that the candidate is not qualified, the Faculty of Graduate Studies has the right to fully reclaim the scholarship.

2. Types of Scholarship Support

Support for an international academic presentation.

3. Financial Value of the Scholarship

The maximum values of the scholarship can be classified according to the presentation locations:

- Asia up to 15,000 – 30,000 for each
- Australia up to 30,000 - 35,000 for each
- Europe up to 45,000 for each
- Africa up to 50,000 for each
- America up to 50,000 for each

4. Application Submission Periods

4.1 Student are required fill out the application form online.

4.2 If the applicant has been given very short notice of his/her acceptance for participation in the conference and cannot submit the application before the date stated in 4.1, he/she must specify the reasons. Nonetheless, the decision depends on the consideration of the Chair of the Scholarship Committee.

4.3 The applicant is required fill out the online application form for the scholarships at <https://graduate.mahidol.ac.th>.

4.4 Applying to receive a refund for a conference /seminar that the applicant already attended is not available.

6. Selection Criteria

6.1 The applicant must receive an acceptance letter for his/her presentation.

- If the seminar/conference is open for both oral and poster presentations, the grant shall be provided for the applicant with oral presentation only.

- In the case of an international conference that is open only for poster presentations, the applicant will be given a similar priority to those accepted for an oral presentation in other conference

6.2 The applicant must apply within the time specified by the Faculty of Graduate Studies.

6.3 Conference to be funded should be a standard.

- Organized by an organization or professional council.

- A peer review meeting for abstract submission.

- An academic conference that has a systematic evaluation of the article by external experts with a full paper of proceedings.

-The conference must not be arranged by an organizer with commercial purposes

6.4 In the case that the number of applicants exceeds the number of the available scholarships, the committee may consider to provide particular students with scholarships of the value less than originally offered in order to expand the opportunity for all students to receive the support.

6.5 Other cases are subject to the committee's consideration and shall be considered as a final decision with no appeal.

7. Terms and Conditions

7.1 The applicant must mention in any part of the presentation that that "This presentation is supported by the Scholarship to Promote Master and Doctoral Students' Competency for International Academic Presentations from the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University."

7.2 Students who receive the scholarship must submit all required documents as stated in the announcement to the Student Services Section, the Faculty of Graduate Studies, within the given period otherwise the grant will be cancelled.

7.3 The student must submit his/her presentation report to the Faculty of Graduate Studies within 15 days after the seminar/conference participation.

8. In cases of matters not covered under this announcement, or with exceptional cases, they would be considered by the Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies on a case-by-case basis.
