The Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University

**Subject: Scholarship to Promote Master and Doctoral Students' Competency
For International Academic Presentations, Fiscal Year 2024**

As for student development, the Faculty of Graduate Studies aims to provide scholarships for master's and doctoral students to present their own academic research in an international presentation for the fiscal year 2024 according to the following criteria and procedures:

1. Qualifications

1.1 The applicant is a student in a Master's or Doctoral program of the institute under the financial supervision of the Faculty of Graduate Studies (excluding the programs under the Faculty of Medical Technology, the Faculty of Tropical Medicine, the Faculty of Environment and Resource Studies, the Faculty of Information and Communication Technology, Mahidol University International College (MUIC), the College of Music, and the College of Management) and is invited to attend an international conference.

1.2 The applicant is a master's or doctoral student whose research title is approved, and so is the advisory committee's approval.

1.3 The applicant must not have previously received this scholarship from the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University.

1.4 The applicant must not receive any scholarship from other sources for the support of an international presentation.

1.5 An applicant must be listed as the first author or co-author of the abstracts presented at the conference. In addition, the name of the applicant's faculty, college, or institute and Mahidol University must be mentioned as the affiliation of the presenter, as well as the logo of Mahidol University, in either a poster or oral presentation.

1.6 In the event that it is later found that the applicant is not qualified, the Faculty of Graduate Studies has the right to reclaim the scholarship fully.

2. Types of Scholarship Support

In support of an international academic presentation.

3. Financial Value of the Scholarship

The following scholarship information is classified based on continents and conference venues:

- Asia, with a maximum of 30,000 for each
- Australia has a maximum of 35,000 for each
- Maximum of 45,000 for each country in Europe
- Africa, with a maximum of 50,000 for each
- Maximum of 50,000 for each in the United States.

The scholarship will be disbursed after the students have completed their presentation and completely submitted documents covering the cost of the presentation and the report of the results of the presentation to the Faculty of Graduate Studies. The scholarship will be paid to students in the actual amount according to the submitted documents, but not exceeding the amount approved before the conference.

4. Application Submission Periods

4.1 The Faculty of Graduate Studies requires the applicant to receive the scholarship via the online system according to the following periods:

4.2 In the event of waiting for conference acceptance, the applicant is required to apply for the scholarship during the period stated in 4.1. And after acceptance from the conference, the applicant must submit the acceptance letter to the Student Affairs section of the Faculty of Graduate Studies.

4.3 The applicant is required to fill out the online application form for the scholarships at <https://graduate.mahidol.ac.th>.

4.4 Applying to receive a refund for a conference or seminar that the applicant already attended is not available.

6. Selection Criteria

6.1 The applicant must receive an acceptance letter for his or her presentation.

- In the event that the seminar or conference provides for both oral and poster presentations, the grant shall be provided for the applicant with an oral presentation only.

- In the case of an international conference available for poster presentations, the applicant will be less supported than for an oral presentation.

6.2 The applicant must apply within the time specified by the Faculty of Graduate Studies.

6.3 The conference to be funded should be a standard, namely.

- Organized by an organization or professional council
- Offering a peer review for abstract submission
- Being an academic conference offering a systematic evaluation of the article by external experts and establishing a full paper as proceedings
- Participating in an organizer without commercial purposes

6.4 Referring to the scholarships, in the event that the number of applicants exceeds the number of available scholarships, the committee may consider offering a chance for an international conference providing less support money than usual.

6.5 Other cases are subject to the committee's consideration and shall be considered a final decision with no appeal.

7. Terms and Conditions

7.1 The applicant must mention in any part of the presentation that "This presentation is supported by the Scholarship to Promote Master and Doctoral Students' Competency for International Academic Presentations from the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University".

7.2 Students who receive the scholarship must submit all required documents as stated in the announcement to the Student Services section of the Faculty of Graduate Studies within the given period; otherwise, the grant will be void.

7.3 The student must submit his or her presentation report to the Faculty of Graduate Studies within 15 days after the seminar or conference participation.

8. Practices and conditions that cannot be performed according to this announcement are subject to the discretion of the Dean of the Faculty on a case-by-case basis.
