Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University

Subject: Scholarship to Promote Master and Doctoral Students' Competency
For International Academic Presentations, Fiscal Year 2025

The Faculty of Graduate Studies aims to provide scholarships for the development of master's and doctoral students to present their academic research abroad during the fiscal year 2025. The application procedure and selection criteria are as follows:

1. Qualifications of an Applicant

1.1 The applicant must be a master's or doctoral student enrolled in a program under the financial coordination of the Faculty of Graduate Studies (excluding the programs offered by Faculty of Tropical Medicine, Faculty of Environment and Resource Studies, Faculty of Information and Communication Technology, Mahidol University International College, College of Music, and College of Management). The applicant must have received an invitation to present their work at an international academic conference.

1.2 The applicant must be a master's or doctoral student whose thesis title is approved and has received approval for the appointment of their thesis advisory committee.

1.3 The applicant must not have previously received any scholarship to promote master and doctoral students' competency for academic presentation at conferences from the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University.

1.4 The applicant must not have received any scholarship from other sources that provide financial support for academic presentation.

1.5 The applicant must be listed as the first author on the abstract to be presented, and Mahidol University must be mentioned as the address of the presenters. Additionally, the logo of Mahidol University must be appeared in both oral presentations and poster presentations.

1.6 In the event that it is later discovered that the applicant does not meet any of the qualifications, the Faculty of Graduate Studies has the right to fully reclaim the scholarship.

2. Types of Scholarship Support

Support for academic presentation at international conferences.

3. Financial Value of the Scholarship

For students applying for the grant, the value of the scholarship is categorized by the continent and the country where the conference is held, as follows:

3.1.1 Asia based on actual expense, but not exceeding 30,000 Baht per grant

3.1.2 Australia based on actual expense, but not exceeding 35,000 Baht per grant

3.1.3 Europe based on actual expense, but not exceeding 45,000 Baht per grant

3.1.4 Africa based on actual expense, but not exceeding 50,000 Baht per grant

3.1.5 America based on actual expense, but not exceeding 50,000 Baht per grant

The disbursement of the scholarship will be made after the student has completed their presentation and submitted the expense documents, along with the report on the presentation results, to the Faculty of Graduate Studies. The scholarship will be provided based on the actual expenses incurred as documented, but will not exceed the pre-approved amount for the presentation.

4. Application Submission Periods

4.1 The Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University, requires the applicant to apply for the scholarship via the online system **at least two months before the presentation** as detailed below:

4.2 In the event of awaiting acceptance from the conference, the applicant is required to apply for the scholarship within the timeframe specified in 4.1. Once the acceptance from the conference is received, the applicant must submit the acceptance letter to the Student Affairs and Networking Development section of the Faculty of Graduate Studies.

4.3 The applicant can apply for the scholarship at <https://graduate.mahidol.ac.th>.

4.4 Applying to receive a refund for a conference that **an applicant already attended is not available.**

6. Selection Criteria

6.1 The applicant must have received an official acceptance letter for the presentation.

- If the conference offers both oral and poster presentations, the Faculty of Graduate Studies will only provide support for the oral presentation.

- If the conference only offers only poster presentations, the likelihood of receiving support will be lower compared to oral presentation.

- For online academic presentations, the Faculty of Graduate Studies will provide support for registration fees, based on actual expenses, but not exceeding 15,000 Baht per grant.

6.2 The applicant must apply within the timeframe specified by the Faculty of Graduate Studies as outlined in this announcement.

6.3 The conferences eligible for financial support should meet the following standards:

- The conference must be organized by a recognized organization or professional council.

- The conference must conduct a systematic evaluation by experts in the relevant field or related disciplines as a selection committee for screening submissions. It should also consistently publish full research papers or proceedings, which may be in the form of a book or electronic media to be distributed either before or after the conference.

- The conference must not be organized by an organizer with commercial purpose.

6.4 In cases where there are a large number of applicants and the available funds are limited, the committee has an aim to support as many students as possible in presenting their academic work abroad; therefore, it may be necessary to approve a grant amount that is lower than the originally offered.

6.5 Other cases are subject to the discretion of the committee, and shall be considered a final decision with no appeal.

7. Terms and Conditions

7.1 The applicant must include the statement in any part of the presentation, "This presentation is supported from the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University".

7.2 Students who receive the scholarship must submit all required documents, as stated in the announcement of scholarship recipient, to the Student Affairs and Networking Development section of the Faculty of Graduate Studies within the specified period. Failure to meet the deadline, the grant will be void.

7.3 Students who receive the scholarship must submit a presentation report to the Faculty of Graduate Studies within 15 days after completing the presentation.

8. Any practices and conditions that cannot be performed in accordance to this announcement are subject to the discretion of the Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies on a case-by-case basis.
