Subject: Grant to Support Graduate Students in Academic Presentations in Thailand Fiscal Year 2024

The Faculty of Graduate Studies aims to provide grants to support our graduate students in presenting their own academic endeavors in Thailand in the fiscal year of 2024. The application procedure and selection criteria are as follows:

1. Qualifications of an Applicant

1.1 The applicant must be a student in a Master's or Doctoral program of the institute under the financial supervision of the Faculty of Graduate Studies (excluding the programs offered by Faculty of Medical Technology, Faculty of Tropical Medicine, Faculty of Environment and Resource Studies, Faculty of Information and Communication Technology, Mahidol University International College, College of Music, and College of Management). In addition, the candidate must be invited to attend and present the academic endeavors in a national or international conference in Thailand.

1.2 The applicant must be a master's (plan A) or a doctoral student whose thesis or dissertation title has formally approved by the committees.

1.3 The applicant must have never received any supporting scholarships for academic presentations in Thailand by the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University.

1.4 The applicant must be listed as a first author or co-author of the academic endeavor that will be presented. In addition, the name of applicant's faculty/college/institute and Mahidol University must be mentioned as the address of the presenter as well as the logo of Mahidol University must be appeared in the tools of presentation either oral or poster presentation.

1.5 The applicant must not be subsidized by other funds.

1.6 In case it is later found that the candidate is not qualified, the Faculty of Graduate Studies has the right to fully reclaim the scholarship.

2. Types of Scholarship Subsidies

To support the presentation for both national and international academic conference.

3. About the Scholarship Subsidies

The Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University, will allocate a budget of subsidies for the expenses as follows:

3.1 Registration fees

- Oral presentation is based on the actual expense – not more than 10,000 Baht.
- Poster presentation is subsidized with 50% of the registration fee on the actual expense – not more than 5,000 Baht.
- Poster presentation of the conference providing only poster presentation is subsidized with 70% of the registration fee on the actual expense – not more than 7,000 Baht.

3.2 Travel (by land) is based on the air-conditioned bus fare type 1.

3.3 Accommodation is subsidized 800 Baht per night by the days of conference.

For the presentation in Bangkok and its vicinity, the subsidy will cover only registration fees; moreover, the grant is subject to the discretion of the support grant committee of the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University.

** Students will be reimbursed for the previously-mentioned expenses after the paper presentation has been completed and the documentary evidence of expenses for the conference attendance, including the presentation report, has been fully submitted to Faculty of Graduate Studies. The amount of the reimbursement will be based on the actual expenses as shown in the documentary evidence, but not exceed the amount specified in the grant approved before the paper presentation. **

4. Application Submission and Selection Periods

4.1 The Faculty of Graduate Studies requires the students to apply for the scholarship via only system as these following periods:

4.2 In case an applicant is waiting for the acceptance from the conference, the applicant can apply for the scholarship during the periods in 4.1. After receiving the letter of acceptance from the conference, the applicant must propose the letter of acceptance and other additional related document to the Student Affairs Section of the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University.

4.3 The Applicants is required fill out the online application form for the scholarships at <https://graduate.mahidol.ac.th/>

4.4 For the conference that an applicant has already attended, the fund will be not available for any finished conferences.

6. Selection Criteria

6.1 The applicants must receive an acceptance letter for his/her presentation.

- If the seminar/conference is open for both oral and poster presentations, the applicants with poster presentations shall receive less amount of the grant.

- In the case of an international conference that is open only for poster presentations, the applicant will be given a similar priority to those accepted for an oral presentation in other conference.

6.2 The applicants must apply within the time specified by the Faculty of Graduate Studies.

6.3 Conference to be funded It should be a standard.

- Organized by an organization or professional council.

- A peer review meeting for abstract submission.

- An academic conference that has a systematic evaluation of the article by external experts with a full paper of proceedings according to the announcement of the

Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University on the Criteria for Dissemination of Thesis for Graduating Master's Degree 2014.

- The conference must not be arranged by an organizer with commercial purpose.

6.4 In the case that the number of applicants exceeds the number of the available scholarships, the committee may consider providing particular students with scholarships of the value less than originally offered in order to expand the opportunity for all students to receive the support.

6.5 Other cases are subject to the committee's consideration and shall be considered as a final decision with no appeal.

7. Terms and Conditions

7.1 The applicant must mention in any part of the presentation that "This presentation is supported by the Scholarship to Promote Master and Doctoral Students' Competency for Academic Presentations from the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University".

7.2 Students who receive the scholarship must submit all required documents as stated in the announcement to the Student Services Section, the Faculty of Graduate Studies, within the given period otherwise the grant will be cancelled.

7.3 The student must submit his/her presentation report to the Faculty of Graduate Studies within 15 days after the seminar/conference participation.

8. In cases of matters not covered under this announcement, or with exceptional cases, they would be considered by the Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies on a case-by-case basis.
