Subject: Postgraduate Admission of International Students

Academic Year 2022

Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University, hereby announces the postgraduate admission of international students, academic year 2022, as follows:

1. Available Programs

2. Admission Schedule

3. Qualifications of Applicants

3.1 Applicant must achieve qualifications as required by individual program

3.2 Applicant must hold a degree from an accredited higher education institution

3.3 Applicant must submit an English proficiency score to fulfill the entry criteria

for one of following tests:

Notes:

- Some programs may set higher entry criteria of English proficiency score. Please refer to the announcement of the Language Center, Faculty of Graduate Studies, regarding to the minimum score for admission at <https://graduate.mahidol.ac.th>
- Set of English proficiency score mentioned in the item 3.3 is the criteria for entry purpose. All students are still required to meet the English proficiency criteria for graduation before taking examination of thesis defense.
- English proficiency score must be within 2-year at the time of application and the score must reach the Language Center, Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University, before the score is expired.
- Applicant who (A) does not submit a minimum English score for entry and/or (B) does not complete the verification of academic record from his/her previous university, and/or (C) is required to fulfill any other conditions as required by the program, and is initially accepted to be a student, shall be categorized as a “**Probation Student**”. He/She must fulfill these entry conditions within the assigned date as mentioned in acceptance letter in order to fulfill a status of “**Regular Student**”. Failure of fulfilling the probation conditions within the assigned period will result in the termination of his/her student status.
- Foreigner who wish to study in a Thai curriculum program must comply with the announcement of the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University, entitled “Operative Guidelines toward the Minimum

Requirements of Thai Language Proficiency for Foreign Students in Thai-Graduate Programs of Mahidol University, B.E. 2564”.

- Applicants must check the admission requirements of the program of study prior to start the application. In case that the applicants do not meet the admission requirements, the Faculty of Graduate Studies will not refund the application fee and will not return all application materials to the applicants.

4. Required Documents

Applicants must upload a scanned copy of following documents in PDF format with maximum file size of 2MB through the online admission system:

1. Degree Certificate
2. Academic Transcript
3. Photo (jpeg format)
4. Passport
5. Curriculum Vitae (CV)
6. Health Certificate
7. Recommendation Letter (at least r referees)
8. English Proficiency Score (submit via English score submission system)
9. Additional documents as required by individual program (such as statement of purpose, letter of work experience, professional license, research proposal, concept paper, publication, etc.)

Notes:

- All documents must be in English version (with official translation).
- Submission of fraudulent documents is prohibited and illegal. In case of this issue, the Faculty of Graduate Studies shall proceed with legal actions including the termination of admission or student status. As a result, application fee, check-in fee and all of tuition fees shall not be refunded.

5. Submission of English Proficiency Score

English Proficiency score must be submitted by either the test center or the applicants to the Language Center, Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University, through

the submission methods as announced by the Faculty of Graduate Studies. It is important that the applicants must ensure the score report to reach the university before it is expired.

6.5 Making payment of application fee through following methods:

- Payment Gateway (Credit Card / Debit Card)
- Invoice (pay at a bank located inside Thailand)
- QR Payment (using a mobile banking application of a Thai bank)

Important Notes:

- Application fee is 500THB for each applying program (non-refundable).
- Applicants must be responsible to pay additional fees as required by the bank (e.g. bank surcharge, transfer fee, currency exchange fee, etc.) to ensure that the equivalent of application fee 500THB will be maintained and successfully transferred to the university's account.
- For the Payment Gateway option, an additional bank fee of 50THB will be automatically included upon the payment is being made.
- Applicants must carefully pay attention to the payment process since any cases of incorrect or mistaken payments shall not be refunded.
- Applicants must complete the online application, upload all required documents and pay the application fee; otherwise the application will not be processed for admission.
- Applicants must submit the online application before 8:00 p.m. (Bangkok Time) and complete the payment of application fee before 10:00 p.m. (Bangkok Time) on the last date of application period.

7. Consideration Process

Consideration process is designed and arranged by individual program which may include a test, written examination, interview, or other evaluation methods.

The evaluation and selection criteria is a combination of various factors such as applicants' academic merit, expectation and purpose, standardized English score, relevant work experience, the potential for future contributions to the academic or professional fields, number of acceptable seats, financial capacity, availability of an appropriate supervisor and institution's resources, personality and attitude of the applicant, etc.

In addition, the applicant's criminal record checking with the authorized Thai government office may be conducted by the university at any stage of the admission. Its result shall be a part of the consideration criteria for admission to Mahidol University.

8. Verification of Academic Record

Successful applicants must comply with the verification of academic record requirements which consist of the verification of academic transcript from previous university and the équivalent qualification process within the assigned date as mentioned in the acceptance letter; otherwise his/her admission or student status may be considered of termination without refunding the application fee, check-in fee, and tuition fee.

10. Announcements

Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University, will issue the application result to the applicants via email. In addition, relevant admission information will be also published at <https://graduate.mahidol.ac.th>

11. New Student Check-In

Successful applicants must complete the new student check-in process and payment of the new student check-in fees within the check-in period as assigned by Faculty of Graduate Studies.

Those who have completed the new student check-in process, but eventually fail to complete either the course registration or the payment of the semester tuition fee

within the assigned period, his/her student status shall be terminated without refunding of the check-in fee including any other payments that have been made by the student.

12. Course Registration and Tuition Fee Payment

New students who have completed the new student check-in must proceed to fulfill the registration for the courses according to the standard curriculum structure (TQF2) of the program of study and complete the payment of the semester tuition fee within the assigned period. The rate of the tuition and fees shall be in accordance with the announcement of the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University.

In case the students' preferred elective course does not open, the student may register for other equivalent course under the approval of the program committee and the Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies. However, the credit fees of some equivalent courses may differ with the original program courses mentioned in the admission announcement.
