Subject: English Proficiency Standard of Graduate Diploma Students, Master Degree Students, and Higher Graduate Diploma Students Academic Year 2020 onwards (Issue 2)
Year 2023

According to the announcement of the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University in the subject entitled English proficiency standard of graduate diploma students, Master's degree students, and higher graduate diploma students enrolling in the academic year 2020 onwards, issued on November 25, 2019.

By doing this, the Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University hereby issues hereby an announcement entitled "English Proficiency Standard of Graduate Diploma Students, Master Degree Students, and Higher Graduate Diploma Students Academic Year 2020 onwards (Issue 2)" as follows.

Item 1: The applicants for both Graduate Diploma in Clinical Science (Dentistry) majoring in Masticatory Science and Graduate Diploma in Clinical Science (Dentistry) and in Oral Medicine in the academic year 2023 onwards must hold one of the English language proficiency test results that **meet the minimum requirement for admission and the standard for graduation** as follows.

Item 2: The Certificate of English language proficiency testing results, according to this announcement, will be accepted only if it is no more than two years old from the date of examination, and applicants must submit the test result to the Language Center, the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University prior to the expiration of the test result.

Item 3: In the case that there is a problem regarding the interpretation or implementation of this announcement, the Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies holds the authority to make a decision and the Dean's decision shall be final.
