Subject: Graduate Students with Disability Scholarship
Academic Year 2026

The Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University, acknowledges the importance of providing equal and inclusive educational opportunities at the graduate level. In alignment with the university's vision to be one of the top 100 universities in the world, it aims to promote educational equality as part of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), specifically Goal 4: "Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all" and Goal 10: "Reduce inequality within and among countries". To support these goals, the Faculty of Graduate Studies has initiated a scholarship program for graduate students with disabilities for the academic year of 2026. The details are as follows:

1. Objective

To enhance the educational opportunities of graduate students with disability in master's and doctoral degrees at Mahidol University.

2. Applicant Eligibility

2.1 Enrolled as a master's or doctoral degree student (from the first year of the second semester onwards when the scholarship is granted) who is currently studying in a graduate program at Mahidol University (except those under the International College and the College of Management) and holds a disability card issued by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Ministry of Social Development and Human Security. For international students, in case of not holding a disability card, they are required to present a certificate from a hospital affiliated to Mahidol University.

2.2 Registered to courses in consecutive semesters and has never taken a leave of absence from study without permission according to the educational regulations of Mahidol University.

2.3 The academic result from the previous semester must be:

- Master's degree with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25
- Doctoral degree with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.50

If the results have not been completely issued, the course lecturer or the program chair shall certify the student's grades as to how they are performing.

2.4 Never hold a record of misconduct against the student discipline according to the regulations of Mahidol University.

3. Scholarship Coverage

3.1 Duration of the scholarships

3.1 Master's degree a period of 2 years

3.2 Doctoral degree a period of 3 years

or when students complete their studies before the scholarship period concludes, whichever comes first.

3.2 Amount of Scholarship

30,000 THB (thirty thousand baht) per semester

4. Application and Announcement of the Result

5. Terms and Conditions of The Scholarship

5.1 Scholarship recipients should not be involved in any misconduct or disciplinary violations as per Mahidol University regulations.

5.2 Scholarship recipients should be registered to courses in consecutive semesters according to the study plan and should never take a leave of absence from study without permission, according to the educational regulations of Mahidol University.

5.3 For scholarship recipients enrolled in courses according to the study plan of the program or according to the advisor's suggestion, they shall be awarded with a grade not lower than B in each course.

5.4 For scholarship recipients registered for thesis or dissertation, they shall be awarded with a symbol of P or S at the end of the semester.

5.5 Students who are awarded the scholarship are required to participate in activities specified by the Faculty of Graduate Studies.

6. Termination of The Scholarship

The Faculty of Graduate Studies will suspend scholarship provision in any of the following cases:

6.1 The scholarship period has concluded.

6.2 “Scholarship recipient” waives the right to receive the scholarship.

6.3 “Scholarship recipient” ceases or resigns from being a student or takes a study leave without acceptable reason.

6.4 “Scholarship recipient” behaves derogatorily or violates the rules and disciplinary code of Mahidol University and/or of the program/faculty/institution/college in which the “scholarship recipient” is studying.

6.5 The chair of the program committee, where the scholarship recipient is studying, proposes to suspend the scholarship.

7. Any procedures, requirements and circumstances not mentioned in this announcement shall be considered at the discretion of the Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies on a case-by-case basis, all decisions hereinafter are final.
