Subject: Scholarship for Graduate-Student Assistants of Students with Disability

Academic Year 2026

The Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University, acknowledges the importance of providing educational opportunities at the graduate level. In alignment with the university's vision to be one of the top 100 universities in the world, it aims to promote educational equality as part of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), specifically Goal 4: "Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all" and Goal 10: "Reduce inequality within and among countries". To support these goals, the Faculty of Graduate Studies has initiated a scholarship program for assistants of students with disabilities pursuing master's and doctoral degrees for the academic year 2026. The details are as follows:

1. Objective

To enhance graduate students who are assistants of students with disabilities in the Faculty of Graduate Studies to acquire public mind and contribute services to society.

2. Qualifications of Applicants

2.1 Be a master's or doctoral degree student (from the first academic year of the second semester onwards at the semester the scholarship is granted) who is currently studying in a graduate program at Mahidol University (except those under the International College and the College of Management),

2.2 Hold consecutive enrollment records with no report of study leave without permission, as stipulated in the Academic Regulations of Mahidol University.

2.3 Have an academic result of at least one academic semester:

- Master's degree with a minimum cumulative GPA of at least 3.25
- Doctoral degree with a minimum cumulative GPA of at least 3.50

In cases where the grade results have not been completely issued, the course lecturer or the program director shall certify the applicant's academic performance.

2.4 Never hold any misconduct records according to the university regulations.

2.5 Have advisors of the students with disabilities report reasons and necessities for assistants of the students and indicate the responsibilities of such assistants, which shall be approved by the program director.

3. Scholarship Coverage

- Master's degree THB 5,000 per month per semester
For a period of 1 semester (no more than 4 months for each semester)
- Doctoral degree THB 6,000 per month per semester
For a period of 1 semester (no more than 4 months for a semester)
Or when students complete their studies before the scholarship period, whichever comes first.

4. Application and Announcement of the Result

Semester	Application Period	Application Deadline	Announcement	Monthly Scholarship Period

Second Semester	From 1 st August 2026	27 th November 2026	30 th December 2026	February 2027 to May 2027

5. Requirements for Scholarships

5.1 Do not hold misconduct or disciplinary violations as per the academic regulations of the university.

5.2 Hold consecutive enrollment records with no reports of study leave without permission, as stipulated in the Academic Regulations of Mahidol University.

5.3 Receive a grade no less than "B" in cases where there are some courses to be enrolled as stipulated in the curriculum or as suggested by advisors.

5.4 Receive a grade of "P" or "S" in the thesis/dissertation course.

5.5 Be available after study hours to academically assist students with disabilities.

5.6 Spend 5 to 10 hours per week assisting, as stated in clause 5.5.

5.7 Submit assistance reports every two months.

5.8 Students who are awarded the scholarship are required to participate in activities specified by the Faculty of Graduate Studies.

6. Termination of the Scholarship

The Faculty of Graduate Studies shall terminate the scholarship disbursement in any of the following cases:

6.1 The scholarship recipient has no longer been a student or has resigned from the university.

6.2 The scholarship recipient behaves derogatorily or violates the rules and discipline of Mahidol University and/or of the program, faculty, institution or college in which the scholarship recipient is studying.

6.3 The scholarship recipient ceases his or her study or holds a study leave without valid reasons.

6.4 The scholarship recipient cannot satisfy the study conditions specified in the scholarship requirement section.

6.5 The scholarship recipient does not fulfill the requirement as suggested and assigned by his or her program.

6.6 The Faculty of Graduate Studies does not receive any assistance reports.

7. Any procedures and requirements that cannot be followed in accordance with this announcement shall be under the consideration of the Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies on a case-by-case basis.
