The following regulations are enacted to ensure the efficient collection of payments other than tuition, registration, and academic credit fees for graduate students and the general public.

Pursuant to item 13 of the Mahidol University Regulations on Budget Management and Finance B.E. 2551, as amended, the Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies, with the approval of the Committee of the Faculty of Graduate Studies at its 9/2567 meeting on September 18, B.E. 2567, issues the regulations for the following payments:

No. 3 Fees collected under this announcement shall be transferred to the Faculty of Graduate Studies. However, fees under item 2.3, shall be submitted as revenue to Mahidol University in accordance with the Mahidol University Regulations on Budget Management and Finance B.E. 2551, as amended.

No. 4 For cases of necessity or other reasons that justify an exemption or reduction of fines, or in matters relating to the implementation of this announcement, the Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies has the authority to make decisions as appropriate. The Dean's decision shall be final.

These regulations shall take effect from October 1, B.E. 2567.
